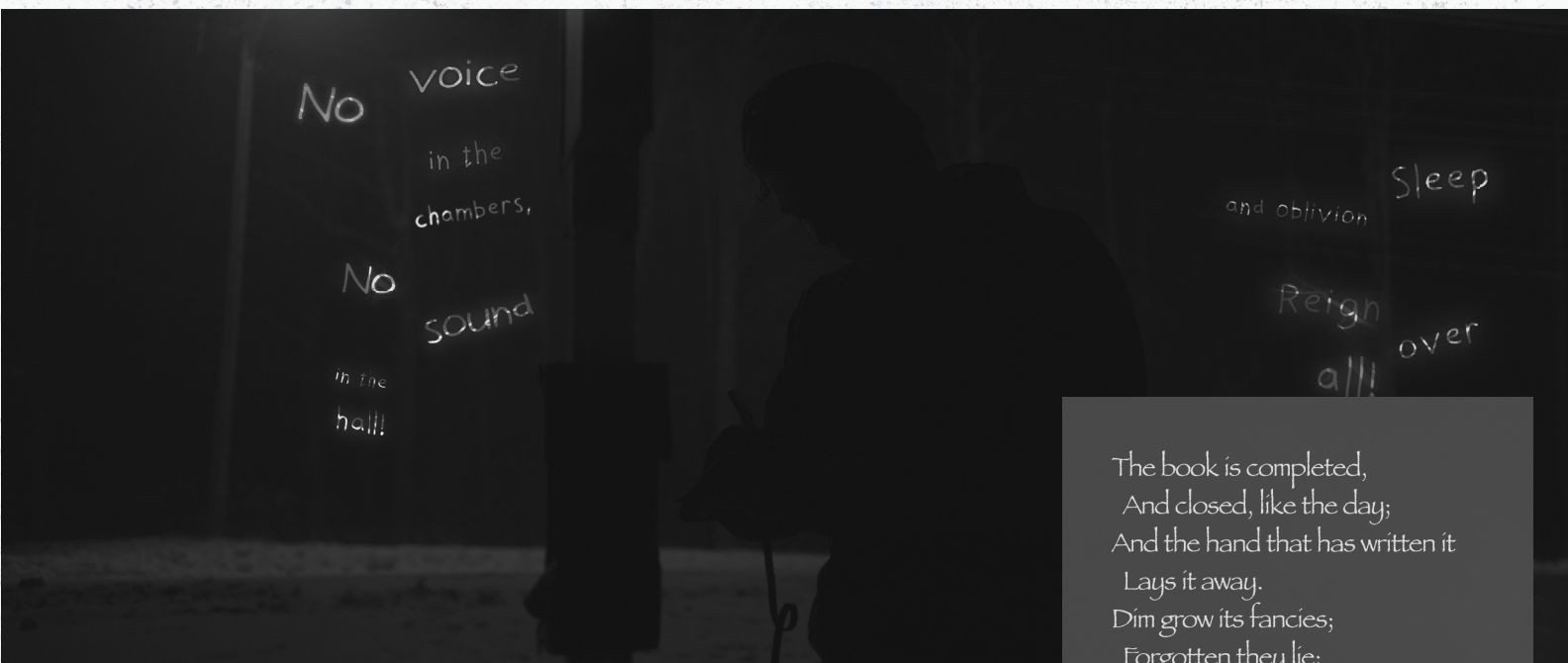
Becoming a Poet

When:

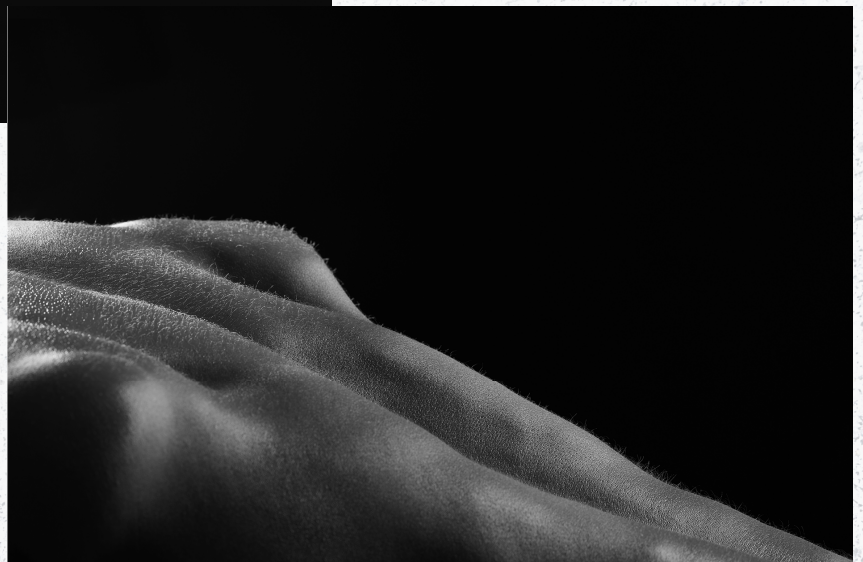
When you see it. This only happens once throughout the entire movie, so don't miss it.
